WDNA Rep Team Player Registration Fees

Issued
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1. Policy Objectives

The WDNA is committed to provide a fair and transparent fee schedule for all players and families while ensuring that the fees cover the operational and growth needs of our Club.

2. Registration Fee Schedule

A Registration fee is charged for each season (Winter and Spring).

The fee amount may vary each season and will be at the discretion of WDNA and the WDNA Rep Teams Sub-committee (RTSC). Registration fees typically include:

- Season fee
- Fundraising levy
- GST
- Transaction fee (to cover charges levied by the bank/payment services provider)
- Any other amount as determined by the RTSC.

Additional charges may be levied across the season:

- Pre-season camp (Autumn season)
- Player attendance at national or international sanctioned tournaments
- Club nights / events
- Player uniforms

3. Payment of Registration fee

Registration fees are due prior to the start of each season and must be paid by the due date using the designated ~~WDNA~~ payment method. Cash will not be accepted.

A fee notice will be provided by the RTSC once the player accepts an invitation for a playing position in a team.

If the payment in full is not received by the due date, the player will not be able to participate in training or games.

Registration fees take priority over any other charge. The WDNA, may at its discretion, apply a payment made for another purpose against the Registration fee balance.

4. Refunds

If a playing position is accepted and the player withdraws before the acceptance close date:

- No playing fees are payable and a full refund will be given
- If any uniform has been purchased and returned in the same condition as it was received, a full refund will be given.

If a playing position is accepted and the player withdraws after the acceptance close date:

- No refund is payable, however:
 - if the player withdrawing is replaced by another player, fees will be payable by each player on a pro-rata basis.
 - the first player accepting the position (and then withdrawing) will be refunded any fees over paid within 30 days of the new player being accepted into the team the player has withdrawn from
 - the second player (replacing the withdrawn player) will be invoiced the pro-rata fees amount
 - between both players, fees equivalent to one player must be received.
- If any uniform has been purchased, has not been worn and is returned in the same condition as it was received, a full refund will be given.
- Any second hand uniform may be purchased back by WDNA depending on the condition and the need. The price paid will be at the discretion of the WDNA.

5. Family Discounts

No discounts will be offered regardless of the number of playing siblings in a single family unit.

6. Genuine Hardship

The WDNA acknowledges that some families experiencing genuine hardship from time to time. In these cases, the WDNA must receive a notification for assistance prior to the payment due date to treasurer@wdna.com.au. The matter will be dealt with confidentially.

The WDNA will agree a payment plan with the family. If payments are not made by the agreed due date, the WDNA at its absolute discretion can:

- Suspend the player from training sessions or games until the outstanding amount is settled
- Renegotiate the payment plan.
- Reduce the Registration Fee payable on the approval of WDNA and the RTSC.
