WDNA Codes Of Behaviour Player September 2012

Issued

Waverley District Netball Association with the support of the Netball Victoria Codes of Behaviour aim to provide a safe and welcoming competition and environment for all our participants and community.

The WDNA Player Code of Behaviour is in addition to the Netball Victoria's Codes of Behaviour and the Waverley District Netball Association General Code of Behaviour.

In addition to Netball Victoria Coach Code of Behaviour:

- A player must not approach a player of another team to question their behaviour or comment (unless positively) on their game
- A player must not openly criticise or chastise umpires and any decision they make during the game
- A player must not openly criticise or chastise players from the other team

Consequences for Breaches of the Player Code of Behaviour

If any breaches of the Codes of Behaviour are deemed to threaten WDNA's provision of a safe and welcoming competition and environment for all our participants and community, the following applies:

- 1. The offending party will be requested to leave the premises
- 2. If the offending party refuses to leave the premises, the party will be suspended from the competition
- 3. Continual offences will result in the offender being suspended from the competition
- 4. If the behaviour does not cease, the team the player represents will be suspended from the competition

If the behaviour does not cease, the team the offender is a member of will be suspended from the competition

Please note; Waverley District Netball Association reserve the right to suspend Clubs if their players continually do not observe and behave within the Coach Code of Behaviour
