Rules	Standard netball rules. Players <u>CAN</u> 'fill-in' for another club/team if details are entered on the scorecard. (During our normal Saturday competition, players can only play for one club.) Scorecards will be distributed for player attendance records.
Uniform	Casual, (formal netball playing uniform not compulsory). -No pockets or zippers -Suitable sports footwear required Teams must have same coloured bibs.
Back to	No finals - Play for fun.
Game times	Will be allocated once team entries are received. The youngest teams will be in the earliest timeslots
Netball Victoria Membership	Players, coaches, and umpires must hold a Netball Victoria membership: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If you have claimed a partial refund, your insurance cover is still current</li> <li>If you have claimed a full refund or have not purchased a Netball Victoria membership in 2020, you will need to register/re-register (cost 50% of standard 2020 fees)</li> </ul>
Attendance records	Every person attending WDNA must be recorded. This is to ensure that in the event of a person testing positive, we can supply the required information to the DHHS.  Please keep our community safe and ensure you register via the displayed QR codes for each area

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Social competitions information...continued	
Face coverings	<p>Face masks which fit securely around the face, covering the nose and mouth areas must be worn by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>all attendees over 11 years old always except when they are on court playing or umpiring. (Scarfs and bandanas are not acceptable)</li> </ul> <p>If you have an exemption, (a copy of your exemption must be made available if requested by a WDNA official) or fall into one of the exception categories, a face mask is not required. However, if you are requested to put on a face mask or provide your exemption or details of your 'exception', please respect the person asking you.</p>
Team numbers	<p>A maximum of 12 people can attend with each team. Include in the 12-person limit are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Players</li> <li>Coach</li> <li>Team manager/scorer</li> <li>Support persons/spectators (to supervise children)</li> </ul> <p>Children under 12 months old are not included in the 12-person limit.</p>
Physical distancing	Please keep at least 1.5 metres away from others if you are not a participant on court.
Court fees	Upon acceptance of entries & confirmation of start date, we will invoice team entry & court fees.
Changes	<p>Updates to how the 'Back to' sessions will run (including proposed 1<sup>st</sup> round dates) may be required if directed by Government and/or DHHS. Any changes will be detailed on our website and we will also keep contact via email with those registered.</p> <p>WDNA will comply with all requirements and know that all those participating will also.</p>

How to register	
<p>We are limited in the number of teams we can accept each competition day. Registrations will be accepted in the order they are received. Teams	Please complete the registration link. (Check that your current club has not entered you already.)
Individuals	We are aware that some teams will not be returning this year however, some players still want to play. This is a great way to meet other players. Complete the registration link and we will match players and create teams.
