Players and teams can play netball in multiple competitions. For example:

- A team can play in the Wednesday night, mixed competition and players from that team can also play in the female only or male competitions.
- A team can play in the Saturday competition and the Thursday night competition

TO ENTER

- Step 1 Enter your team via the WDNA website- 2021 competitions [here](#) by entries close date. Please note: as the night competitions are new, late team entries may be accepted depending on room in the selected competition.
- Step 2 Once your team has been accepted, pay your team entry fee (invoices will be sent).
- Step 3 Enter your team into My Netball. Instructions for current clubs and teams can be found [here](#) to renew your team entry Instructions for new clubs and teams will be forwarded once we have set you up in My Netball.

PLAYING FEES

An invoice will be issued for the full season once team entries close however, playing fees can be paid weekly.

Please note: if your team gives a walkover, you will be invoiced both yours and the non-offending teams court fees for that game.

WDNA IS A CHILD SAFE ORGANISATION

Umpires, coaches, team managers, club and association committee members, and any other volunteer or official in a position of authority over 18 years old must:

1. Have a current Working with Children check (WWCC) or equivalent (e.g., VIT).
2. Have completed the free, online Play by the Rules-Child Protection course. The link to this course [here](#). This takes about 45 minutes to an hour to complete.

NETBALL VICTORIA MEMBERSHIP

All players, coaches and umpires participating in one of our competitions, must hold a Netball Victoria Membership and a Waverley District Netball Association membership (\$10) before you participate.

RULES

The playing rules shall be those of the "All Australian Netball Association unless otherwise stated in these bylaws." WDNA Bylaws, policy documents and forms are available [here](#).

MATCHES

Matches: Length of quarters is dependant on which competition you enter.

Tuesday and Wednesday 4 x 10 minute quarters

Thursday 4 x 15 minute quarters

FIXTURES

Fixtures will be available online prior to the commencement of each season. Fixtures can be found through MyNetball or on the WDNA Website [here](#). You can find more information on how to access the fixtures and results through MyNetball [here](#).

FIRST AID

Will be provided each day / night competitions are held.

UNIFORM

Clubs/independent teams entering a WDNA competition are to provide details of their playing uniform.

Playing uniform can consist of: -Playing dress, Skirt or skorts & polo/T shirt, Shorts (pocket free), Leggings/skins (black or club colour), Long sleeve tops (Club colour under official playing uniform. If Club colours are not readily available, the Club may elect a different colour (e.g., black, or white).

WALKOVERS

Any team not ready for play at starting time will be penalised one (1) goal per minute to the maximum period of one quarter. At the end of the first quarter, the match will be awarded to the non-offending team. A corresponding 0 – 10 score will be credited against the offending team.

All players on the score sheet of the non-offending team, will be credited with a played game while the offending team players will not.

The Club / Team giving the walkover should email walkovers@wdna.com.au no later than 5:00 pm on the night before the scheduled game.

Walkover penalties - Walkovers notified after 5:00 pm on the on the night before the scheduled game may incur a \$50 penalty payable before the Team's next scheduled match as well as the loss of points. WDNA will notify the Club if a penalty applies within 48 hours of the scheduled game time.

All walkovers during the Finals series will incur a \$100 fine.

The penalty is in addition to teams giving a walkover in the Night Competitions will be responsible for paying their court fees and the non-offending teams court fees for that match.

TRANSFERS AND CLEARANCES

Any player wanting to transfer to another Club/team during the season, must apply in writing to the WDNA committee, accompanied by a clearance from their registered Club/Team.

No transfer permit shall be granted after the seventh (7) round of seasons matches.

All players are free to move between Clubs at the conclusion of the season up to the receipt of the current season's team entries. A financial penalty will apply to and Clubs registering players without a clearance.

FINALS

Finals: Final Series Matches shall be played as follows:

Preliminary finals – 1 v 4, 2 v 3

Grand finals – Winners of 1 v 4 and 2 v 3 of the preliminary finals.
