Waverley District Netball Association COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN

Updated 25 January 2021

The purpose of this COVIDSafe plans is to:

- Provide our plan for the implementation and management of netball activities at WDNA
- Have arrangements set out to prevent the transmission of COVID-19 amongst our community. (Including volunteers, members, participants, coaches, officials, administrators, visitors, family members.)
- Provide a framework to govern the general operations of netball activities at WDNA.
- Tell the behaviours expected of all members, participants, officials, and visitors.
- Inform how we will be monitoring attendance and the report of the health of attendees at the venue.

WDNA accepts as key principles:

- The health and safety of our community attending the venue is the number one priority.
- Clear communication is required for our community on our return to netball plans.
- The importance of upgrading hygiene protocols.
- Measures are put in place to mitigate the risk of transmission of COVID-19.
- Netball activities cannot resume until operations are finalised and approved.
- At every stage, we must consider and apply all restrictions and regulations.
- We need to be prepared for any localised outbreak at our venue.

WDNA retains the responsibility for the effective management and implementation of the return to netball activities and operations outlined in this Plan.

WDNA is responsible for:

- Approving the Plan and overseeing the implementation of the arrangements in the Plan.
- Ensuring the plan reflects up to date information from the Victorian Government and public health officials.
- Revising the Plan as required.
- Complying with the current *Coronavirus* (*COVID-19*) requirements (e.g., reopening roadmap: metropolitan Melbourne, *COVIDSafe Summer restrictions*).

WDNA Expects our community to:

- Comply with ALL health directions of the Victorian Government and public health authorities.
- Comply with physical distancing and the wearing of face coverings.
- Understand and act in accordance with this Plan as amended from time to time.
- Act with honesty and integrity on the state of their personal health and any potential COVID-19 symptoms.
- Not attend the venue if displaying COVID-19 symptoms.
- Record their attendance at the venue vie QR codes and/or team sheets.
