

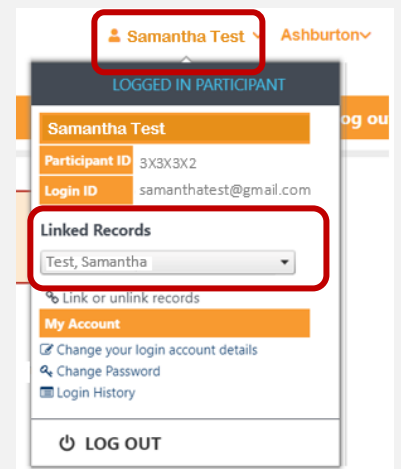
STEP 1

You can enrol in and access netball related courses through <http://my.netball.com.au/>. If you are unsure of your username and password, or are new to netball, follow the appropriate link.



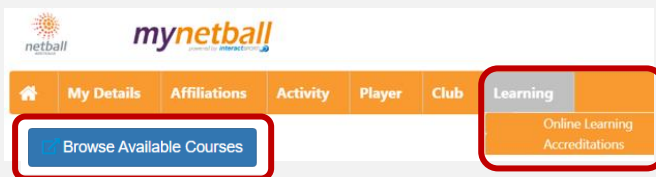
STEP 2

Once logged in, look in the top right-hand corner to verify that you are viewing your record and not that of another family member. Your account may be linked to other members of your family. Use the Participant Selector in the top right-hand corner and the Linked Records drop down list to switch to the appropriate person if required.



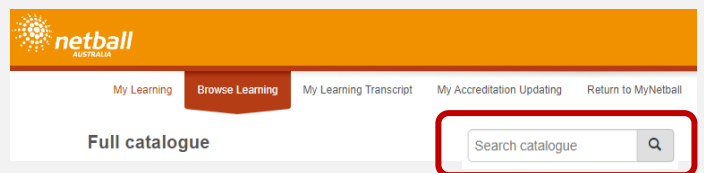
STEP 3

Access courses under the Learning heading. Select *Online Learning*. And then *Browse Available Courses*.



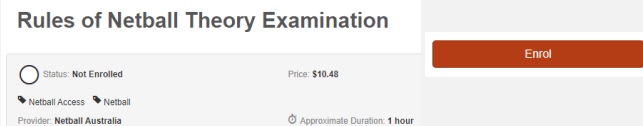
STEP 4

The full catalogue of courses will be listed. The Umpire courses required at WDNA are 'Rules of Netball Theory' and 'Foundation Umpire Education Course'. In the Search bar enter the course name and hit search.



STEP 5

The course you have searched for will appear. Follow the steps to enrol and pay (if payment is required). After your payment has been accepted you can start learning by clicking Launch.



Course enrolments and completions from MyNetball Learning will be updated in MyNetball overnight and will show in the 'My Courses' tab of the My Learning page. Click on Completed to view courses that you have completed. Those with a certificate will show a green rosette icon. Click on this icon to download your certificate as a PDF document
