Waverley District Netball Association COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN

Updated 19 October 2021

The purpose of this COVIDSafe plan is to:

- Provide our plan for the implementation and management of netball activities at WDNA (Ashwood courts and Oakleigh Recreation Centre.)
- Have arrangements set out to prevent the transmission of COVID-19 amongst our community. (Including volunteers, members, participants, coaches, officials, administrators, visitors, family members.)
- Provide a framework to govern the general operations of netball activities at WDNA.
- Outline the behaviours expected of all members, participants, officials, and visitors.
- Inform how we will be monitoring attendance and the report of the health of attendees at the venue.

WDNA accepts as key principles:

- The health and safety of our community attending the venue is the number one priority.
- Clear communication is required for our community on our return to netball and ongoing netball plans.
- The importance of upgrading hygiene protocols.
- Measures are put in place to mitigate the risk of transmission of COVID-19.
- Netball activities will cease if directed by the Victorian State Government, the Monash Council or Netball Victoria.
- At every stage, we must consider and apply all restrictions and regulations.
- We need to be prepared for any localised outbreak at our venues.

WDNA retains the responsibility for the effective management and implementation of the return to netball and ongoing netball activities and competitions and operations outlined in this Plan.

WDNA is responsible for:

- Approving the Plan and overseeing the implementation of the arrangements in the Plan.
- Ensuring the plan reflects up to date information from the Victorian Government and public health officials.
- Revising the Plan as required.
- Complying with the current Coronavirus (COVID-19) requirements (e.g., Victoria's Roadmap: Delivering the National Plan plus any remaining requirements from the reopening roadmap: metropolitan Melbourne, COVIDSafe Summer restrictions and any updates).

WDNA Expects our community to:

- Comply with <u>ALL</u> health directions of the Victorian Government and public health authorities.
- Comply with physical distancing and face coverings requirements.
- Comply with vaccination requirements for participation and attendance (refer WDNA 09 COVID Vaccination Requirements Policy)
- Understand and act in accordance with this Plan as amended from time to time.
- Act with honesty and integrity on the state of their personal health and any potential COVID-19 symptoms.
- Not attend the venue if displaying COVID-19 symptoms.
- Not attend the venue if their local LGA/suburb is in lockdown as directed by the Chief Health Officer.
- Record their attendance at the venue via the Service Victoria issued QR codes on display.
- Show proof of vaccination on check in at our venue

Attendance – management of unwell participants	Our first aid attendant will assist in the immediate management and treatment of the systematic person and arrange cleaning and sanitising the indoor facilities used by this person.
	WDNA will follow the health guidelines on reporting.
Attendee – suspected case of COVID-19	If you display symptoms of COVID19, please ensure you have a COVID-19 test as soon as possible.
	If you have attended a game at the Ashwood courts and afterwards, are advised to self-
	isolate or diagnosed with COVID-19, please notify us 'in confidence' at admin@wdna.com.au All information will be kept confidential however, this allows us to gather information that we may be required to provide to the DHHS.
Attendee – confirmed case of COVID-19	DHHS will notify us of a confirmed case of coronavirus (COVID-19) and will advise if we need to stop netball activities or can continue operating.
	We will be assigned a case manager from their dedicated and specialised team to ensure we are supported throughout the process.
